Conditions of Sale and Disclaimer of Warranties

We recommend you read carefully the Conditions of Sale and Disclaimer of Warranties printed in this catalog.

Important Notice regarding Motorcycles:

Some of the motorcycles offered in this sale are being offered with a Bill of Sale only. Please refer to the Conditions of Sale for further information and limitations regarding certificates of title and the registrability of motorcycles offered at auction.

Admission to Preview and Auction

All Bonhams sales are open to the public. Please bring your catalog to the sale as entry is by catalog only. Each catalog allows two people entry on the preview and sale days. Further copies of the catalog can be purchased at the sale venue. Bonhams has the right at its sole discretion without assigning any reason therefore to refuse admission to its premises or attendance at any of its sales by any person.

Buyer's Premium and Sales Tax

The hammer price will be subject to a buyer's premium, for motor vehicle property the premium is 17% on the first \$100,000 of the bid (hammer) price and 10% of any amount by which the bid price exceeds \$100,000. For memorabilia and other non-motor vehicle property, the premium is 25% on the first \$50,000 of the bid (hammer) price and 20% of the amount of the bid price above \$50,000 up to and including \$1,000,000 and 12% on any amount exceeding \$1,000,000.

For payments made entirely in cash or cash equivalent, a reduced premium rate will apply, as set forth in the Conditions of Sale. Additionally, buyers are required to pay any applicable import duty, sales or user tax, as the case may be.

IMPORTANT TAX NOTE: All items being sold will be subject to Nevada state sales tax. All buyers will be required to pay tax unless you qualify for one of the following tax exemptions:

1. You are a licensed automobile or motorcycle dealer, who has provided a copy of your dealer's license. A completed resale certificate from your home state will also be required. All out of state dealers must also provide proof of shipping to their home state through an ICC carrier in addition to a notarized affidavit of purchase. A valid driver's license must also be provided.
2. A qualified non resident of Nevada can purchase an \$8.25 drive away permit and complete the non resident affidavit to avoid Nevada sales tax. Buyers must provide an out of state driver's license and social security number to qualify for this exemption.

Bidder Registration

In order to bid at a Bonhams sale you will need to register to bid. This can be done by completing a bidder registration form such as the one at the back of this catalog. If you are not known to Bonhams, you may be asked to supply a bank reference or other suitable reference when you register. You may wish to pre-arrange suitable check or credit approval, and we recommend you speak with Martin Romero at Bonhams Cashier's office in San Francisco or with Paul Atterton at Bonhams' head office in London.

Reserves

The seller may place a reserve on its property which is the minimum hammer price the seller is prepared to accept for a lot. This figure is confidential.

Estimates

These are an indication of where we feel the levels of bidding will reach exclusive of the buyer's premium and tax; however, lots may achieve prices higher or lower than the published estimates. Where 'refer department' is stated please contact one of the specialists for the latest up-to-date estimate.

Bidding

The auctioneer will open the bidding below the low estimate and usually proceed in increments of around 10% of the bidding price. The auctioneer may vary the bidding increments and may split or reject a bid at his or her discretion. At Bonhams, you can bid in many ways: in person, via absentee bid or over the phone. Absentee bids can be submitted in person, online, via fax or via email. By bidding at auction, whether in person or by agent, by absentee bid, telephone or other means, the buyer or bidder agrees to be bound by the Conditions of Sale. We assume no responsibility for failure to execute bids for any reason whatsoever.

Absentee Bids

Bonhams can execute absentee bids when instructed. Lots will be bought as inexpensively as is allowed by other bids and reserves. Please ensure you send your absentee bid to Bonhams in good time prior to the sale. If a bid is faxed, it should be sent to Bonhams at +1 (415) 861 8951 or to Bonhams at the Auto Collections at the Imperial Palace at +1 (415) 391 4040 on or after Tuesday January 10.

Telephone Bids

References

Unless arrangements are made with Bonhams for payment in advance of the sale all lots will be removed to storage at the buyer's expense. In any event, the purchase price should be paid to Bonhams no later than *12pm Saturday January 14*.

Damage

Any viewer who damages a lot will be held liable for all damage caused and shall reimburse Bonhams or its agents for all costs and expenses relating to rectification of such damage.

Customs Duty

Motor vehicle customs duty, calculated at 2.5% of the import value, and associated import fees are payable on all lots marked with a dagger (†). However, if the purchased lot is exported within certain criteria, the duty may be refundable.

Payment

Payment for purchased lots must be made no later than *12pm on Saturday January 14*. Bonhams recommends anyone wishing to clear items immediately to pay by cash, certified check (bank draft) or credit card.

COLLECTION, REMOVAL, TRANSPORT, STORAGE AND SHIPPING OF LOTS

Lots must be paid for and collected from the sale venue by 12pm Saturday January 14. Bonhams hours at The Auto Collections on Friday January 13 are 10am to 6pm, and on Saturday January 14 from 10am to 12pm. Please note that purchased motorcycles can not be released during the auction. Buyer collection can begin directly after the auction.

Lots are at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer. It is strongly advised that overseas purchasers and absentee bidders make arrangements regarding collection with Bonhams in advance of the sale.

Representatives of Bonhams preferred carriers will be present at the sale and can arrange transportation as agents for the buyer or the seller as the case may be. An agent may collect your purchases as long as they are removed from the auction site by 12pm Saturday January 14.

It is the responsibility of the buyer to separately inform their shipper of the location of the property, its collection and forwarding, the costs of which will be paid for by the buyer after the applicable uplift and storage charges have been paid. Buyers should satisfy themselves that they have collected all relevant log books, title documents and keys relating to their lot(s) at time of collection. Otherwise lots shall be removed to storage at the buyer's expense (see below).

MEMORABILIA UNCOLLECTED lots will be removed to Box Brothers' Las Vegas location for shipment or for collection by buyer or third party agent. Instructions for collection from Box Brothers will be given to buyers at the time of payment. Box Brothers will be at the preview and auction to assist clients with shipping quotes. Removed Memorabilia lots will not be available for collection after 12pm on Saturday January 14 until Monday January 16 at 9am. Please note that uncollected Memorabilia lots that are removed to Box Brothers for storage or shipping are subject to uplift charges applied according to the size and fragility of a lot or lots. Lots are also subject to storage fees.
